



### Want to Spend Some Quality Time With Your Best Friend in Lent?

Here's an opportunity not to spend time with your friends Mary or Susie, Frankie or Joe, but rather, with Jesus Christ. This special time is called "Adoration", and is precious time spent in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

The story is told of St. John Vianney who observed an old man come into church quite often and simply sit there for a long time. Out of curiosity, St. John asked him what he was doing. The old man replied humbly, "Nothing. I look at him and he looks at me." Good friends don't need to say much.

In our world filled with noise, busyness, media devices, stress and pressure, Adoration is a profound antidote to heal hearts that need spiritual renewing. Lent is a time to focus on God, dwell on Christ's Passion and Death, and reflect on the transformation of our hearts. It's an opportunity to watch, and wait and pray solemnly with Jesus... unlike the apostles who fell asleep in the Garden of Gethsemane as they kept vigil! Our own patron saint, St. Margaret Mary, received a vision from Jesus who told her to rise in the middle of every Thursday night, and 'keep me company in humble prayer to my Father, exactly as I spent that night in agony.' Each Friday during Lent, our parish will have Adoration in the chapel from after 8:00 am. Mass until before the 5:30 pm Mass. A book of prayers will be available in the chapel. It is imperative that at least 2 adorers be present while the Blessed Sacrament is exposed. 

# Regulations for Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday, March 6, 2019 and Good Friday, April 19, are days of fast and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence.

*Fasting* is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

*Abstinence* is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.


