

Congratulations Father Michael

on the 25th Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood

With a love for helping others, it was no wonder Father Michael Giglio became a priest after retiring as an English teacher. “My concern for people,” he said when asked why he would enter the priesthood at such a late age. For 30 years, he instructed children in the classroom, professing everything from Latin to Shakespeare. While teaching and earning his master’s degree in English, the ministry had a profound influence on his eventual decision to follow his dreams of entering the seminary. “The thought (of priesthood) was always with me,” he said. “But I didn’t act on it. I was very involved in my work as an English teacher.”

A Brooklyn native, he attended St. Catharine of Alexandria, there the seed for priesthood was planted. He had served as a member of the parish council, Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, lector and religious education teacher. The realization of retirement made him examine his purpose and how to utilize his spare time to help others. He went to Pope St. John XXIII National Seminary in Weston, Massachusetts, where older seminarians go to prepare for Ordination.

Ordained at 55 on May 28, 1994, Father Giglio has been consistent in his passion helping others. As a diocesan priest, Father Giglio was pastor of three parishes — St. Anthony in Lakeland, St. Teresa in Titusville and Epiphany in Port Orange — he also assisted at several others, including his first assignment of Holy Family in Orlando. Even now, at 82, he still finds his motivation in “continuing in the ministry as best as I can, and to help out in the parishes, and to hear Confessions.”


MORE IN-DEPTH DISCIPLE MAKER SURVEY RESULTS

INVOLVEMENT


% of our parish that participated in the activities below during the past year.



Saint of the Month


Saint Oscar Romero, Martyr

Óscar Romero (August 15, 1917 – March 24, 1980), commonly known as Monseñor Romero, was a priest of the Roman Catholic Church in El Salvador. He later became prelate archbishop of San Salvador.



As an archbishop, he witnessed numerous violations of human rights and began a ministry speaking out on behalf of the poor and victims of the country's civil war. His brand of political activism was denounced by the government of El Salvador. In 1980, he was assassinated by gunshot while consecrating the Eucharist during Mass. His death finally provoked international outcry for human rights reform in El Salvador.

In 1997, a cause for beatification and canonization into sainthood was opened for Romero and Pope John Paul II bestowed upon him the title of Servant of God, and he was canonized by Pope Francis on October 14, 2018. He is considered the unofficial patron saint of the Americas and El Salvador.



Pro-Life Prayer Vigil for an End to the Death Penalty: *On the eve of the scheduled execution of Robert Joseph Long*

Wednesday, May 22, 6:00 pm (Chapel)

"Our faith tradition offers a unique perspective on crime and punishment, one grounded in mercy and healing, not punishment for its own sake. No matter how heinous the crime, if society can protect itself without ending a human life, it should do so. Today, we have this capability.

We are all sinners, but through the Father's loving mercy and Jesus' redeeming sacrifice upon the Cross, we have been offered the gift of life everlasting. The Lord never ceases his loving pursuit of us in our sin and brokenness, offering us the choice of life over death. The use of the death penalty cuts short any prospect for transforming the condemned person's soul in this life. Catholic opposition to the death penalty, then, is rooted in mercy. It is also eminently pro-life, as it affords every opportunity for conversion, even of the hardened sinner. As followers of Jesus, we have the "inescapable responsibility of choosing to be unconditionally pro-life" (*Evangelium Vitae*, # 20).

The Church's opposition to the death penalty should not be seen as indifference to the sinfulness of crime and attacks on human life, but as an affirmation of the sacredness of all life even for those who have committed the most heinous of crimes. The Scriptures remind us: "Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy" (Lk 5:7). As Christians, we are called to oppose the culture of death by witnessing to something greater and more perfect: a gospel of life, hope, and mercy. To help build a culture of life, capital punishment should be abolished."


