Interview with M. Dubonheur Fleurimond

How does the Livestock Program help you? Answer: The program helps me very much. I had some problems when I didn't have an animal. When I received the livestock, I began to have something that helps me. She gave birth to babies, I turned one back to the program. She gave birth again I sold and paid tuition. I have a kid who was in hospital, she was having a cesarean operation, I sold to help her in the hospital.

Did you have a goat before? Answer: No, I didn't have goat before. It is thanks to Saint Margaret Mary I am a beneficiary, I have a goat.

How many goats do you have now? Answer: I have only one, only the mother. She is pregnant now.

How many did you sell? Answer: I have sold two.

Why did you sell the two goats? Answer: I sold the two to pay tuition and I had a kid, she was sick, I sold the other, I went to pay at the hospital.

Do you use the goats manure to plant crops? Answer: Yes, I use the goats manure to plant crops: I plant plantains, i plant okra.

Doesn't that help you with the kids? Answer: Yes, that helped me very much with my kids. It is thanks to the St Margaret Mary program I don't have a lot of problems when the kids were sick in my hand; when the teachers asked for tuition it is thanks to Saint Margaret Mary, I find to sell to pay tuition. I am benefited very much, I am so in joy for what St Margaret did for me.

Please tell us how it works with your goat. Answer: On the training, they told us to give a profit. For the first litter, the goat gave birth to one baby. I gave it as profit. The mom was served by the male, she got pregnant and gave birth to two babies. The babies grew up. With those two babies, It helped me for school. I had my kid who was sick in hospital having a cesarean, I sold. That helped me to pay hospital.

How do you help people in the community in the program you are? Answer I help people in the community with the program. I give a baby back so that they can give to others so that they can move with the program.

What are you going to say to saint Margaret Mary? Answer: What I'm going to say to Margaret Mary: I am so happy, I am so joyful, I said "hello" and I said a big thank you for what they did for me and what they will continue to do for me because what they give to me, the good is still here.
