"Do you hear what I hear? Said the little lamb to the shepherd boy. Do you hear what I hear? Ringing through the sky, shepherd boy. Do you hear what I hear?"

It is not only the little lamb, but all of scripture which cries out to us to notice the new reality, the new presence in our world: Emmanuel, our



mighty God, one with us in our humanity. Our liturgies during this first period of Ordinary time begin to sound out what it means that Jesus is in our midst, teaching, healing, calling us by name. Do we hear? Do we listen?

There is a way of knowing whether we are really listening. We will know by whether we trust and whether we act. The Apostle Andrew listened to the voice of Jesus, and went to share the good news with his brother, Simon Peter. It's not blind trust. It's trusting HIM. And then following HIM. The liturgy not only instructs us but actually stirs up in us the hope and trust to act.

We follow Him and become disciples even before we're used to calling ourselves that. In the readings of this Liturgical Season we see that discipleship goes beyond our individual lives too and moves us to follow Him into our communities and our world, where His presence is breaking down barriers and offering peace. Our encounter with Him in the Eucharist offers us this transformation. How can we not respond?

In the Eucharist this Liturgical Season we celebrate "God-among-us." Listen, Trust, Follow.



NEW ALTAR SERVER TRAINING FOR 5TH GRADE AND OLDER

Altar Servers enhance the quality of liturgical celebrations by assisting the priest in various ways during the Mass and by taking part in liturgical processions. Not only does the Altar Server offer an extremely important service in the Liturgy, but it is also a wonderful way for young people to learn and understand the elements that comprise the Mass. A server can expect to be scheduled to serve at weekend Masses about once or twice a month and scheduling is done according to each family's availability. Boys and girls in the 5th grade or higher who have received their First Holy Communion are eligible. New altar server training begins **Monday, February 5**, in the Church and continues for four additional weeks from 6:30 to 8:00 pm on the days/dates specified below, also in the Church. Each new server must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to the first session on February 5. New servers are expected to attend all five sessions: Feb 5, 12, 19, 26, and March 4. All sessions are from 6:30 - 8:00 pm.




