

ALMSGIVING PROJECT: SENIORS FIRST

Saturday, February 17 - Palm Sunday

This year's Lenten Alms Collection will benefit Senior's First, Inc. of Orlando.

Seniors First offers the choice, hope and quality care needed for senior independent living.

Founded in 1966, they offer a vital support system to vulnerable, older adults aged 60 and up and adults of all ages living with disabilities in both Orange and Seminole counties. They provide Meals on Wheels, and other nutrition programs, in-home care, medical equipment, a community food pantry and public guardianship to help individuals age in place.

Their goal is to help seniors meet their daily living needs at home, which greatly impacts their health and ability to remain living

independently. With community-based assistance, seniors can thrive at home where they are happiest.

Donation envelopes can be found on the tables near the church exits and are available in the church office. Envelopes can be placed in the collection basket or returned to the church office, or you can scan the QR code on the envelop and donate electronically.

HOLY LAND GIFTS AVAILABLE

March 2/3 after all Masses (Courtyard)

This past Christmas looked different in Bethlehem, for the first time in modern history, there were no Christmas trees or Christmas celebrations. The birth of the Prince of peace was celebrated in Holy Mass only.

Holy Land Gifts will be visiting our Parish the weekend of March 2/3 to sell their olive wood gifts to help relieve the dire Christian situation in the Holy Land. Olive wood carvings are made in home workshops by Catholic families in the city of Bethlehem who rely on their sales to pilgrims and tourists as their main source of income.

The recent war halted tourism to the Holy Land, all souvenir shops are now closed resulting in 90% unemployment among the carvers. Many families were forced to leave their land and houses and immigrate trying to find a secure place to live in, which led to the

percentage of the Christian population to drop from 92% to 1.5%.

In this dire situation, the handcrafted articles that are for sale at the courtyard of the church are the sole source of income for the families in Bethlehem and Jerusalem. This will help bring food to their tables, but if you can't afford purchasing any, just remember the Catholics of the Holy Land in your prayers and please pray for peace. Also, pray for all the innocent lives of women, children, and elderly who have been killed in the war.

Let us put our hands together to help 600 Catholic families stay in their land with dignity to keep the Christian identity over there. The carvings make great and unique sacramental gifts, for your convenience, checks, cards and cash will be accepted.

SMM CAPITAL OUTREACH GRANT PROGRAM

Since the completion of the Parish Hall and church offices in the early 2000's, St. Margaret Mary has offered a Capital Outreach Grant Program. The grant program provides funds to assist non-profit organizations that serve people in need. Grant deadlines are March 1 and September 1 of each year.

Its inception was directed by Fr. Walsh who wanted to make sure we, as a parish, continued our call to discipleship outside the walls of our Winter Park location. And so, for the last 20 or so years, we have provided more than 350 grants to over 140 different organizations in central Florida and abroad. A grant committee reviews each of the applications and as a group, determines whether an award is made and what amount is appropriate based on the request, need and scope of impact of the use of the funds.

If you know of an organization that might benefit from a grant, the applications can be found on the church website under Ministries/Advocacy & Christian Service and the next deadline is March 1, 2024.
