





FLORIDA EXECUTION SET FOR AUGUST 28

Pope Francis calls on Catholics to strengthen their own sense of hope, but also to "be tangible signs of hope for our brothers and sisters who experience hardships of any kind" in his invitation to celebrate a Jubilee Year beginning in December. Specifically, Pope Francis asks us to "be one in demanding dignified conditions for those in prison, respect for their human rights and above all the abolition of the death penalty, a provision at odds with Christian faith and one that eliminates all hope of forgiveness and rehabilitation."

Consider responding to this call by urging Gov. DeSantis and the Board of Executive Clemency to stop the execution scheduled next Thursday. SMM CAPITAL OUTREACH GRANT PROGRAM

Since the completion of the Parish Hall and church offices in the early 2000's, St. Margaret Mary has offered a Capital Outreach Grant Program. The grant program provides funds to assist non-profit organizations that serve people in need. Grant deadlines are March 1 and September 1 of each year. Its inception was directed by Fr. Walsh who wanted to make sure we, as a parish, continued our call to discipleship outside the walls of our Winter Park location. And so, for more than the last 20 years, we have provided more than 375 grants to over 150 different organizations in central Florida and abroad.

A grant committee reviews each of the applications and as a group, determines whether an award is made and what amount is appropriate based on the request, need and scope of impact of the use of the funds.
