

# Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will be offered on Saturday, March 1 at the 5 pm Mass

This sacrament is for ..."the faithful whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age...The sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious. A sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is

the reason for the surgery. Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present." (Pastoral Care of

the Sick)

In short, anointing prays for recovery; it helps the "sick person...to bear suffering bravely...[and] fight against it" (*Pastoral Care of the Sick, 6*). While a return to physical health may follow anointing, the grace received in the celebration provides spiritual strength, hope, and healing.

### Holy Land Gifts in the Courtyard

#### March 8-9 after all Masses

Holy Land Gifts will be visiting our parish to sell their olive wood gifts to aid the dire Christian situation in the Holy Land. Olive wood carvings are made in home workshops by Catholic families in the city of Bethlehem who rely on their sales to pilgrims and tourists as their main source of income.

The recent war halted tourism to the Holy Land, all souvenir shops and hotels are now closed. This has resulted in a 70% unemployment rate among the carvers. The Catholics of the Holy Land ask for the support of your prayers and the purchase of these handcrafted artworks that can make unique Easter and sacramental gifts. Proceeds from sales generate much-needed employment opportunities and monetary funds for 600 Catholic families in Bethlehem. Cards, cash and Apple Pay will be accepted. ### From the Mental Health Ministry for February:

Pope Francis reminds us:

"As we continue to celebrate the 33<sup>rd</sup> World Day of the Sick in the Jubilee Year 2025, the Church invites us to become "pilgrims of hope". Hope does not disappoint" (Rom 5:5); indeed, it strengthens us in times of trial. These are comforting words, but they can also prove perplexing, especially for those who are suffering. How can we be strong, for example, when our bodies are prey to severe, debilitating illnesses that require costly treatment that we may not be able to afford? How can we show strength when, in addition to our own sufferings, we see those of our loved ones who support us yet feel powerless to help us?

Places of suffering are frequently also places of sharing and mutual enrichment. How often, at the bedside of the sick, do we learn to hope! How often, by our closeness to those who suffer, do we learn to have faith! How often, when we care for those in need, do we discover love! We realize that we are all "angels" of hope and messengers of God for one another, all of us together."
