In the following weeks, we hear of repentance, conversion of heart, and God's patient mercy. We encounter the call to deeper faith, to lay down our burdens, and to trust again in the Lord's saving love. Because these readings consistently invite us back—to prayer, to trust, to repentance, and to renewed life in Christ—we have chosen "Return" as our Lenten theme. Lent is not about starting over in shame, but about coming home to the Father who never stops calling us back.

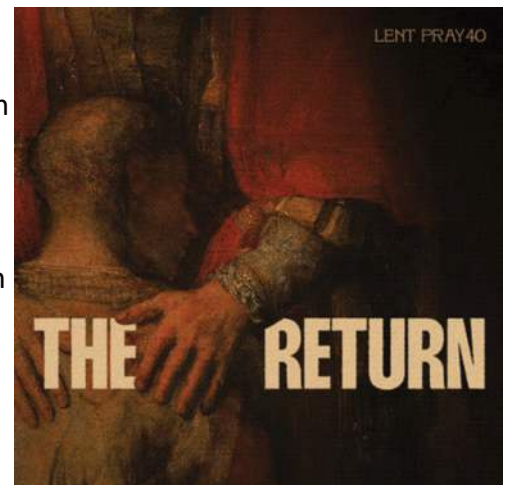
Pray40 Lent Challenge on Hallow
