What are the scrutinies? When we scrutinize something, we look at it carefully and examine thoroughly. Through the scrutinies, the elect will carefully look at anything that keeps them from Christ. They are “meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect, and then to bring out and strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.” Each scrutiny has a different theme: Christ as Living Water, Christ as Light of the World, and Christ as the Resurrection and the Life.

This Easter, the parishes across the Diocese of Orlando will welcome over 940 individuals into the Catholic faith.

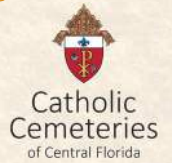

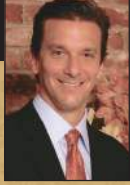
