WHAT IS CURSILLO?

Cursillo (pronounced kur-see-yo) is a Spanish word meaning 'little' or "short concentrated course" in Christianity. It is a world-wide movement of the Catholic Church that assists men and women in developing a relationship with Our Lord that may be lived and shared.

PURPOSE OF CURSILLO:

In today's world can Christianity penetrate the many areas of secular life? Can it transform the world in a way that is more fruitful than the past and in keeping with the times? The Cursillo Movement thinks so! It proposes no new type of spirituality, but simply a method through which one's spirituality may be adopted, lived, and shared in any area of human life in a natural, loving way.

WHAT HAPPENS AT A CURSILLO WEEKEND?

The Cursillo weekend begins on a Thursday evening and ends on Sunday evening. During those three days the Cursillistas (those attending) live and work together, listen to talks given by religious and lay persons, and participate in spiritual activities. They also attend daily Mass, receive Eucharist, pray the Rosary and visit the Blessed Sacrament.

WHO SHOULD MAKE A CURSILLO?

The Cursillo is designed for those Christians who desire to grow in their Christianity, to share their faith, and to seek more joy and purpose to their faith.

Seven Weeks of Easter Seven Themes of Catholic Social Teaching

During the seven weeks of the Easter season, the U.S. Bishops invite us to learn about the Seven Themes of Catholic Social Teaching, which offer wisdom about building a just society and living lives of holiness amidst the challenges of modern life. Week 6 focuses on the theme 'The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers.' The Church teaches that the economy must serve people, not the other way around. If the dignity of work is to be protected, then the basic rights of workers must be respected--the right to productive work, decent and fair wages, the organization and joining of unions, private property, and to economic initiative. Resources about these themes are available on the Bishops' website.

Prayer Vigil on the Eve of an Execution

Wednesday May 20, 6 PM (Courtyard)

"To punish with lifelong imprisonment is not to minimize the heinousness of Mr. Hitchcock's crimes. It is rather to recognize with awe that God is the author of life, and to reserve to him the taking of human life except where it is otherwise impossible to maintain the common good," wrote the Florida Bishops' Conference, explaining their opposition to his execution. The Bishops regularly request that Catholics both pray for an end to the use of the death penalty and also contact the Governor seeking a stay of execution for each person for whom he signs a death warrant. Learn more at flaccb.org/flcan-take-action. Our Peace & Justice Ministry will lead a brief prayer vigil about the death penalty on the eve of the next scheduled execution in our state; gather in the courtyard (chapel in event of rain) after evening Mass on May 20.

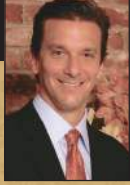

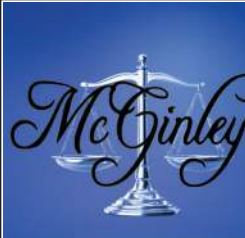
