Dear Parishioners,

On this glorious feast of Pentecost, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit to the Apostles and their bold beginning of bringing the message of Christ to all the world. Significant changes began to happen to the mission of this budding Church because of the power of the Spirit. Throughout history, these changes have continued to happen, even to this day.



One such change, which occurred while I was in Haiti last week, is my decision to retire as Pastor became official. I asked our Principal, Mrs. Walsh, and our Director of Operations, Mr. Scott Brogan, to share this timely news with you, and I thank them for doing so.

When I think about my retirement from this wonderful parish after 41 years, two scripture verses come to mind immediately:

- First, the familiar verse from Ecclesiastes:
"There is an appointed time for everything, and a time for every event under the heavens." (Eccles. 3:1)
- Second:
"Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." (1 Thes. 5:18)

I believe the time is right for my retirement, and I am deeply grateful for my years here. Serving you, our parishioners, has been a profound privilege. Sharing in your moments of joy and sorrow, helping build this faith community through worship and service, and working with our wonderful Staff have been such blessings for me. I sincerely thank you, the members of this parish, for all the ways you have supported me in my ministry here as your Pastor. Together, with God's grace, we've strived to work together to build the kingdom of God not only in our parish, but throughout our community and Haiti, serving those in need, especially the poor. My plans for now, beginning mid-summer, include a break in Ireland where I'll be a farmer and shepherd of 4-legged sheep, then return to this area to serve in ministry where I'm needed.

I feel strongly that I am leaving you in very good hands. Fr. Christopher Dorsey will begin his ministry here in mid-summer. Some of you may remember him when he was with us as a seminarian. I have every confidence in our Staff who are great leaders in their fields, as they work with Fr. Dorsey during this transition. And, without a doubt, I know you will welcome him warmly, as I was welcomed here years ago.

Finally, please know, from the bottom of my heart, that you will always be in my thoughts and prayers. To each of you, my deepest and humble thanks for the opportunity to pray with you, walk with you, minister to and with you, these beloved 41 years.

WHAT IS CURSILLO?

Cursillo (pronounced kur-see-yo) is a Spanish word meaning 'little' or "short concentrated course" in Christianity. It is a world-wide movement of the Catholic Church that assists men and women in developing a relationship with Our Lord that may be lived and shared.

PURPOSE OF CURSILLO:

In today's world can Christianity penetrate the many areas of secular life? Can it transform the world in a way that is more fruitful than the past and in keeping with the times? The Cursillo Movement thinks so! It proposes no new type of spirituality, but simply a method through which one's spirituality may be adopted, lived, and shared in any area of human life in a natural, loving way.

WHAT HAPPENS AT A CURSILLO WEEKEND?

The Cursillo weekend begins on a Thursday evening and ends on Sunday evening. During those three days the Cursillistas (those attending) live and work together, listen to talks given by religious and lay persons, and participate in spiritual activities. They also attend daily Mass, receive Eucharist, pray the Rosary and visit the Blessed Sacrament.

WHO SHOULD MAKE A CURSILLO?

The Cursillo is designed for those Christians who desire to grow in their Christianity, to share their faith, and to seek more joy and purpose to their faith.

Prayer Vigil on the Eve of an Execution

Monday June 1 6 pm (Courtyard)

Florida has yet another execution less than 2 weeks after the last state sanctioned killing. Pope Leo has released a 2 minute video statement celebrating the 15th anniversary of death penalty abolition in Illinois and encouraging work to end it throughout the U.S. He stated, "I likewise offer my support to those who advocate for the abolition of the death penalty in the United States of America and around the world. I pray that your efforts will lead to a greater acknowledgment of the dignity of every person, and will inspire others to work for the same just cause." Watch his statement and find action alerts to protest upcoming executions across the country at catholicismobilizing.org. Please write to the governor requesting a cease to executions in Florida and attend our parish prayer vigil (June 1 at 6 PM) against the death penalty on the evening preceding the next Florida execution.

Call on Congress to make ending hunger a top priority by taking part in our 'Bread for the World' campaign. Our Bishops ask us to write our Senators urging them to do more to help families put food on the table by strengthening anti-hunger programs both in the United States and abroad. 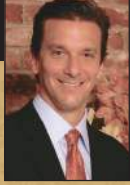
