Beloved Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

Jesus prays that we may be one with God and live as we are named through, with, and in Christ Jesus. We have heard from Sts. Peter and Paul throughout the Easter season that we bring forth Jesus the Eucharist when we serve one another for then we are serving God.

Your pastor, Father Walsh, has led you to know, love and serve God. He will officially retire on July 1, becoming pastor emeritus. I know you join me in prayers of gratitude for his humble, faith-filled ministry these many years. I am pleased to announce the appointment of Father Christopher Dorsey as Parochial Administrator of St. Margaret Mary Catholic Church, effective July 1. Father Dorsey served during his pastoral year as a seminarian in 2013 at St. Margaret Mary. I introduce Father Dorsey to you.



Christopher Dorsey was born on July 9, 1986, in Spokane, WA to his parents, Leo and Mary. He is sibling to sister, Candice, and brother, Nicholas. He graduated from the University of Central Florida in 2008 with a BA in English. His family relocated to Melbourne, and Holy Name of Jesus Catholic Church, Indialantic became their home parish. He received the Sacrament of Holy Orders on May 23, 2015, at St. James Cathedral. He was ordained to serve the Diocese of Orlando and the Archdiocese for the Military Services as he felt called to minister as a chaplain for the men and women who serve in the Armed Forces.

On June 4, 2019, Father Christopher Dorsey was appointed a United States Army Chaplain. His first assignment was at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri with the 84th Chemical Battalion. The all-encompassing assignment led him to provide faith formation, sacramental preparation, opportunities for fellowship, and moral and spiritual direction for the soldiers and their families. In 2021, Father Dorsey was assigned the chaplaincy at Camp Zama, Japan. Father Dorsey was the only Catholic priest in Japan serving the United States Army. He was advisor to Christians and those who did not know God. He remembers speaking with a soldier who was not Catholic and not married and was pregnant. He spoke to her about this extraordinary gift of life, and she chose to embrace this gift, instead of choosing abortion, which had been advocated by the father of the child.

Upon the conclusion of his tour with the Archdiocese for the Military Services, Father Dorsey was appointed Parochial Administrator of St. Mary Magdalen Catholic Church, Altamonte Springs. Beloved people of God, welcome Father Christopher Dorsey with the Peace of Christ. Gather him into your parish community as he gathers you to be one with God.

THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most beloved devotions in the Catholic Church. The image of the Sacred Heart reminds us of the deep and personal love Jesus has for every person. His Heart, burning with love and crowned with thorns, reflects both his mercy and his suffering for the salvation of the world.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart calls us to:

- Trust in the love and mercy of Jesus
- Make reparation for sin
- Grow in prayer and holiness
- Live with greater charity and compassion
- Entrust ourselves, our families, and our nation to Christ

The Sacred Heart of Jesus holds a particularly special place in the life of our parish because our patroness, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, received visions of Jesus in which he revealed his Sacred Heart and invited the faithful to grow in love, trust, prayer, and devotion to him. Through St. Margaret Mary, devotion to the Sacred Heart spread throughout the Church and continues to draw countless people closer to the merciful love of Christ.

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is celebrated this year on Friday, June 12.

As the United States prepares to commemorate the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence in 2026, the bishops of the United States will consecrate our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 11 during a special Mass in Orlando. Also, we will have a special Consecration of our parish in our Church.

CONSECRATION OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The Consecration of the United States to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus will take place during a Votive Mass celebrated on June 11 at the Basilica of the National Shrine of Mary, Queen of the Universe in Orlando, while the bishops are gathered in Plenary Assembly.

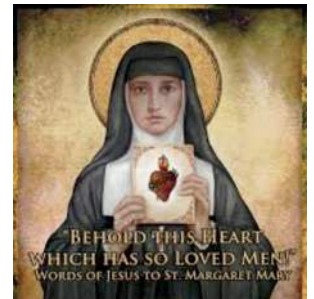

As a parish named in honor of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, whose visions helped spread devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus throughout the world, we are especially blessed to deepen our love for his Sacred Heart.

On the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, Friday, June 12, our parish family will gather for Mass at 5:30 pm in the Church, during which we will consecrate St. Margaret Mary Parish to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

All parishioners are warmly invited to join us as we entrust our parish, our families, and our lives to the loving and merciful Heart of Jesus, praying for healing, unity, renewal, and deeper faith.

WHAT IS A NOVENA?

A novena is a traditional Catholic devotion consisting of prayer prayed over nine consecutive days. The word “novena” comes from the Latin word novem, meaning “nine.” Novenas are often prayed:



- In preparation for a feast day
- For a special intention
- For healing or guidance
- To grow spiritually
- To ask for God’s grace through the intercession of Jesus, Mary, or the saints

This year, the Sacred Heart Novena begins on Wednesday, June 3 and concludes on Thursday, June 11, in preparation for the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, June 12.

HOW TO PRAY THE SACRED HEART NOVENA

The Sacred Heart Novena consists of three prayer sections. Traditionally:

1. Begin with the intention you wish to bring to Jesus.
2. Pray each section slowly and prayerfully.
3. Pray: One Our Father, One Hail Mary, One Glory Be
4. Repeat the phrase: "Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you."

The novena may be prayed individually, as a family, or with a parish community.

THE LITANY OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The Litany of the Sacred Heart is a beautiful prayer of invocation and trust in the love of Christ. The approved litany contains 33 invocations corresponding to the years of Christ’s earthly life and was officially approved for public use by Pope Leo XIII in 1899.

The litany reflects upon the many attributes of Christ’s Sacred Heart, including:

- Source of life and holiness
- Burning furnace of charity
- Vessel of justice and love
- Patient and rich in mercy
- Hope of those who die in him

We will pray the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus each day following the 8:00am Mass beginning Wednesday, June 3 and concluding Thursday, June 11.

Prayer Vigil on the Eve of an Execution

Monday June 1 6 pm (Courtyard)

Florida has yet another execution less than 2 weeks after the last state sanctioned killing. Pope Leo has released a 2 minute video statement celebrating the 15th anniversary of death penalty abolition in Illinois and encouraging work to end it throughout the U.S. He stated, "I likewise offer my support to those who advocate for the abolition of the death penalty in the United States of America and around the world. I pray that your efforts will lead to a greater acknowledgment of the dignity of every person, and will inspire others to work for the same just cause." Watch his statement and find action alerts to protest upcoming executions across the country at catholicmobilizing.org. Please write to the governor requesting a cease to executions in Florida and attend our parish prayer vigil (June 1 at 6 PM) against the death penalty on the evening preceding the next Florida execution.

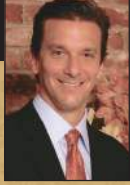

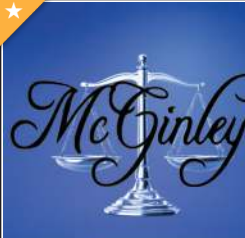
