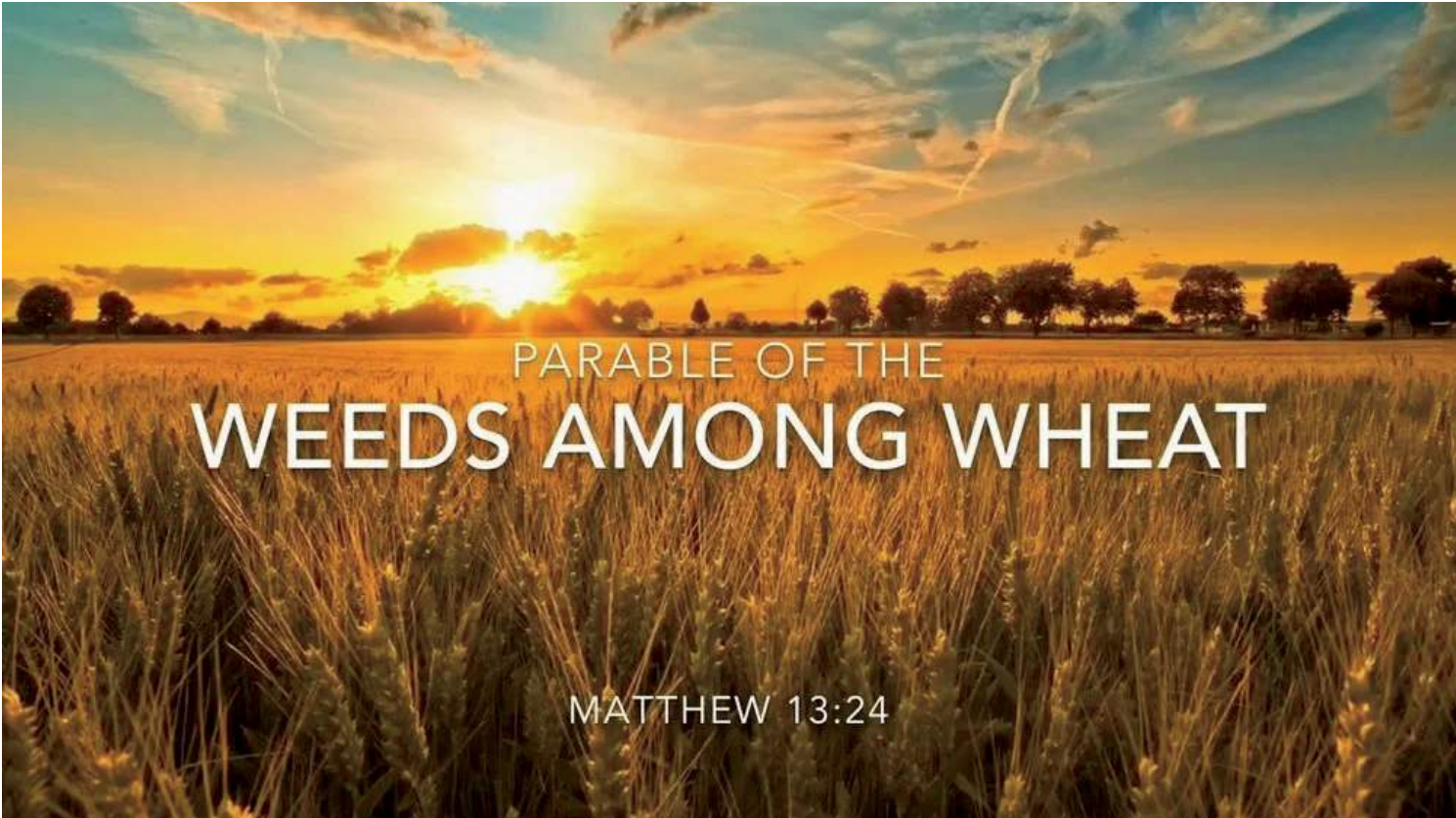




PARABLE OF THE WEEDS AMONG WHEAT

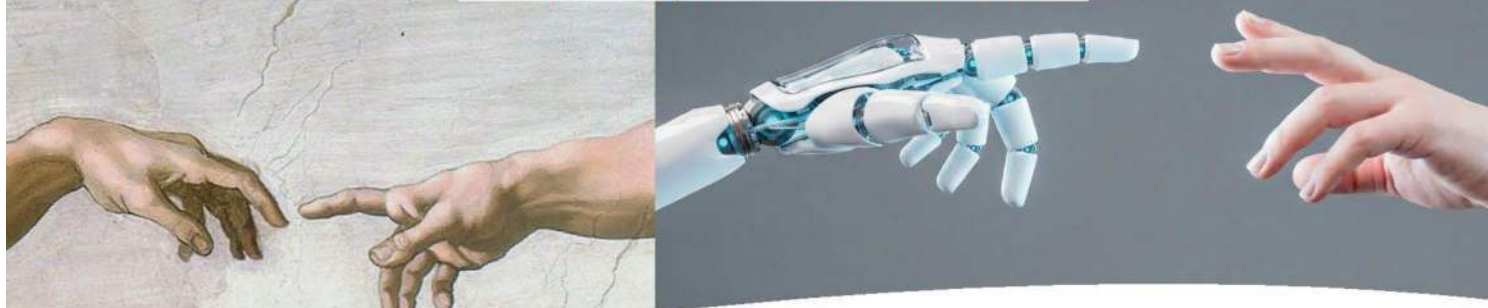

Magnifica Humanitas

5 POWERFUL QUOTES FROM POPE LEO XIV'S FIRST ENCYCLICAL, MAGNIFICA HUMANITAS



Pope Leo XIV's first encyclical, *Magnifica Humanitas*, offers a sweeping reflection on the human person in the age of rapid technological change, especially in the rise of artificial intelligence (AI). As the document addresses questions of dignity, justice, and moral responsibility, it speaks directly to the challenges of modern life, grounding its vision in the timeless truth of the Gospel. From the meaning of true human progress to the ethical demands of new technologies, Leo XIV calls the Church and the world to a renewed sense of solidarity and hope.

Here are five powerful quotes from Pope Leo XIV's first encyclical—words that illuminate the Catholic Church's vision for human dignity, ethical AI, and the future of a more faithful, Christ-centered world.



In the era of artificial intelligence, when human dignity is threatened by new forms of dehumanization, ours is the pressing duty to remain profoundly human. We must lovingly safeguard the grandeur of humanity bestowed upon us and revealed in its fullness in Christ, the splendor of which no machine can ever replace. True progress always stems from a heart open to others, an intelligence willing to listen, and a will that seeks what unites rather than what separates. (MH 15)

Leo XIV frames the Christian response to artificial intelligence not with fear but with a return to what it means to be truly human. Real progress is not measured by power, speed, or efficiency but by our ability to live in communion with others—listening with openness, seeking wisdom, and choosing unity over division.

Technology can grow in strength and sophistication, but it cannot replace what makes us most human. It is love—rooted in being created in the image of God and lived out in relationship—that reveals our true dignity and gives meaning to all progress.



The Church reminds us, with a firm yet humble voice, that true fulfillment is not achieved by eliminating weakness but through harmonious growth. It is found where freedom and responsibility are intertwined with mutual care and true solidarity, and where progress is measured by the dignity of each person and the good of all peoples. (MH 12)

Leo XIV reminds us that true fulfillment is not found in technological “perfection” or in trying to eliminate every human limitation. From a Catholic perspective, real growth is about becoming more fully human before God.

Our weaknesses do not remove our dignity; they are part of our human condition, which Christ heals and redeems. True progress is not measured by power, control, or performance but by how we love, serve others, and faithfully respect the dignity each person holds from being created in the image of God.

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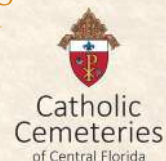
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
